ALL MEMBERS WITH FORWARDERS CARGO (CARGO INSURANCE) PROGRAMMES

This notice applies to all TT Club Members with Forwarders Cargo programmes including those Members who insure these risks with TT Club Mutual Insurance N.V. where TT Club Mutual Insurance Ltd acts as reinsurers.

Please note that with effect from 13th March 2026 the Club has updated the list of excluded areas under its Forwarders Cargo covers for War, Strikes, Riots and Civil Commotions Risks, to reflect changes in the Listed Areas issued by the LMA Joint Cargo Committee (JCC) Global Cargo Watch List dated 4th March 2026.

Coverage under the Institute War Clauses (Cargo) CL 385 dated 1.1.09 and/or Institute War Clauses (Air Cargo) CL 388 dated 1.1.09 and/or Institute Strikes Clauses (Cargo) CL 386 dated 1.1.09 and/or Institute Strikes Clauses (Air Cargo) CL 389 dated 1.1.09 is excluded for any claim occurring in locations of 'high risk' (2.4 - 3.1) or above as shown in the list (at the date of commencement of transit).

Conclusion

For those Members with Forwarders Cargo programmes, the areas in which War, Strikes, Riots and Civil Commotions Risks cannot be covered has been expanded to include six countries in the Middle East.

The Defined Areas within the Watch List are unchanged and therefore continue to classify PERSIAN OR ARABIAN GULF and adjacent waters including the Gulf of Oman as 'Severe'.
